If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 5th highest placing will be used to determine the winner.

The Veteran categories are open to both **Men & Women**. Women Veterans will receive an additional **8 years** on Target Time. The Veteran's competitions will be run over the same distance as the Women's competition. Any Veteran Men wishing to compete in the Men's competition must clearly indicate this to the event organiser when entering

The competition for Paracyclists is based on a "Factored Time" system.

**In 2015 an Espoir is someone born after 31<sup>st</sup> December 1992 & before 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1997**

## Cycling Time Trials Scholarship

Cycling Time Trials are pleased to continue with their Scholarship for young riders. The Scholarship enables a small number of riders to be based in Europe and sample Continental Racing.

In order to be eligible riders would generally be expected to:-

- be under 25 on the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the year that they want to race on the continent.
- be good all-rounders (road racing and time trialling).
- show prominently in the RTTC- Classic Series.

The scholarship is open to riders of either sex.

## Course Description

Start In Longnor by entrance to school; proceed on B5053 (towards Glutton) take left to turn at edge of Longnor before top of hill and proceed along unclassified road to the Travellers Rest Inn on A53. Turn left on to the A53 towards Leek and proceed to the Royal Cottage, turn sharp left towards Longnor. In Longnor turn left into Calder Green and left again onto Buxton Road to continue past the start (11 miles) and complete a further 1 or 2 laps. The finish on the second or third lap is just before the left turn onto Calder Green in Longnor.

## Prize Presentation

If you can, please stay for the prize presentation, which takes place as soon after the finish as possible.

Staying until the end shouldn't be too hard as the Women's race is last on the programme and looks likely to be an exciting and close contest between national, world and Olympic champions!

## Parking

There is NO competitor or spectator parking at the HQ. Please park in Longnor's central square and streets, taking care not to obstruct or inconvenience residents. Please do not park on the course.

## Regulations

Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. Any competitor who crosses the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

No "U" turns in the vicinity of the start and finish. Observers will be watching.

Head up and observe local regulations at all times.

Pace must not be given or received and the onus is on the caught riders to adhere to this rule.

The Athletes' Prizes are awarded to the fastest riders who complete the 2-lap and 3-lap events using "road race equipment" rather than "time trial equipment". This means that riders will use standard road bikes without aero extensions (including clip-ons) and will not wear time trial helmets. Disc wheels are not permitted but all others that could be used in a road race will be accepted. Eligibility will be assessed on the start line by the timekeeper whose decision will be final.
