Points will be awarded on the basis of 60 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for sixtieth place in **National Events** and 40 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for fortieth place in each District Event.

The winners will be the riders with the highest aggregate total of points gained from up to five events (either National or District events).

If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 6th highest placing will be used to determine the winner.

The Veteran categories are open to both **Men & Women**. Women Veterans will receive an additional 8 years on Target Time. The Veteran's competitions will be run over the same distance as the Women's competition. Any Veteran Men wishing to compete in the Men's competition must clearly indicate this to the event organiser when entering.

The competition for disabled riders is based on a loading system.

In 2011 an Espoir is someone born after 31st December 1988 & before 1st January, 1993

The 2011 series will also include a Team Award

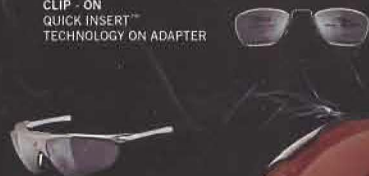
