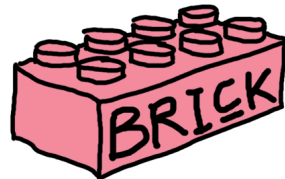

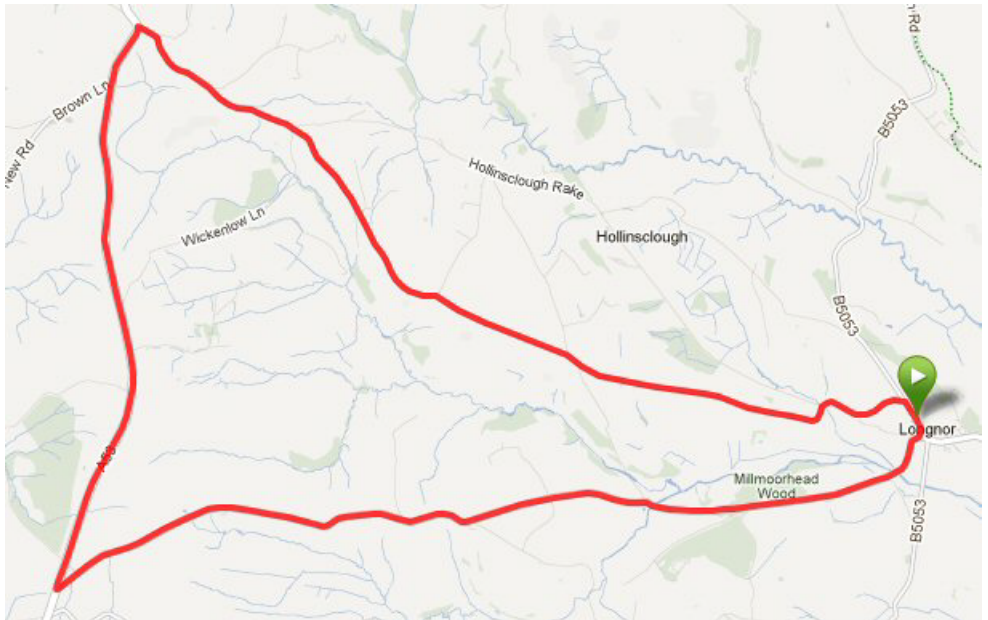

Course Description

Start In Longnor by entrance to school; proceed on B5053 (towards Gluton) take left to turn at edge of Longnor before top of hill and proceed along unclassified road to "Travellers Rest Inn" on A53; turn left on to the A53 towards Leek and proceed to "Royal Cottage"; turn sharp left towards Longnor, In Longnor turn left in to "Calder Green" and left again on to "Buxton Road" to continue past the start (11miles) and complete a further 2 laps. The finish on the second or third lap is just before the left turn onto "Calder Green" in Longnor.

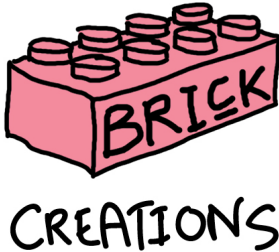

Cycling Time Trials are pleased to continue with their Scholarship for young riders. The Scholarship enables a small number of riders to be based in Europe and sample Continental Racing.

In order to be eligible riders would generally be expected to:-

- be under 25 on the 1st January in the year that they want to race on the continent.
- be good all-rounders (road racing and time trialling).
- show prominently in the RTTC- Time Trial Series.

The scholarship is open to riders of either sex.
